What's the next step for your church?

Only your church can know God's unique assignment for your congregation and your community. But we want to walk alongside you as you work to discover what that assignment is and bring it to life, or go deeper.

Transformed & Transforming is about learning from, and sharing with, other congregations. It's about equipping individuals and congregations for mission. It's about developing new ministries in your community and around the world. It's about becoming a thriving, mission-focused, culturally relevant denomination.

It's about journeying together as we explore new ways to follow God's call.

As your church moves forward in mission, transformation, or leadership development, these equipping opportunities are offered to help you take the next step.







Your short-term service can have long-term impact.

Serve alongside RCA missionaries and trusted mission partners, using your gifts in meaningful ways.

Send a mission team from your congregation over spring break. Spend a few weeks helping people put their lives back together after a disaster. Encourage a college student who's contemplating ministry to check out a summer volunteer internship.

RCA Volunteer Engagement also offers resources and training for churches and volunteers:

- Help with the planning process
- Resources for spiritual growth during a mission trip
- Support on the field
- Tools to help with debriefing and follow-through

The most effective way for you to reach people for Christ is to start a new church.

If your congregation has a heart for people who are far from God, consider taking the next step by planting a church. You could be a vital part of the RCA's goal to plant 350 new churches by 2028.

New churches need parent churches—established congregations that offer support and guidance. Parents help church plants thrive. Many parent churches experience new life themselves when they take a step of faith and start a new church.

Want to go deeper with church planting? New congregations need church-planter pastors. If you sense God may be calling you to pastor a church plant, evaluation, training, and coaching are available.

Share the love of Jesus, in word and in deed, with people around the world.

That's the heart of global mission. If it's also the heart of your congregation, take the next step.

Align your mission efforts with your identity and calling as a congregation. Learn how to participate directly in the mission work you support.

Start by reflecting, with your congregation, on your current mission work and what you want it to look like. What *could* it be? What *should* it be? Through a progressive planning process, leaders in your church will develop a mission action plan and decide what *will* be—and figure out how to make it happen.

An RCA facilitator will walk with you, offering tools and other help. If you're looking for new mission opportunities, the facilitator will make suggestions that line up with your passions. Churches with similar passions will have the opportunity to connect in a network and work together to multiply their impact.

As churches live out their mission action plans, they'll pay it forward and walk with another congregation through the process.
